# SUMMER CAMP



The moment our campers step onto Long Island marks the beginning of an incredible journey. Our summer camp offers a transformative experience that sets the stage for building confidence, creating connections, and experiential learning.



## OUR PROGRAM AREAS



### Aquatics

In our 50 meter pool, lifeguards teach beginner swimmers the basics and help advanced swimmers improve. In the harbor, teens spend their days fishing, sailing, kayaking, and exploring watersports with experienced guides.



### Sports & Fitness

We cover all the bases with highly trained and experienced coaches & programs (including visits from Boston pro athletes and partners.) There's basketball, lacrosse, football, biking, soccer, tennis, baseball, golf, and more.



### Knowledge Is Power

We offer STEM-related experiential learning all summer long to let teens have fun while learning new skills beyond summer camp.



### Leadership Development

We believe there is a leader in everyone and we provide leadership and community-building opportunities for campers from hands-on activities on the field to the top of the climbing tower and high ropes course.



### Arts

Campers explore visual arts and music with expert staff and partners.

# FAMILY SERVICES



When youth enroll in our year-round Leadership Academy, their families are eligible for family services including resource coordination, food support, direct cash assistance, and family engagement events. Family engagement events cultivate a connected community of families who are there for one another when it matters most.

# LEADERSHIP ACADEMY



The Leadership Academy aims to equip young people with essential skills for high school and beyond. Teens who participate in CHV's summer camp can further their development through year-round programs for grades 9-12. During the school year, participants attend weekly Community Nights featuring grade-specific curricula and personalized support, along with Saturday workshops that emphasize social-emotional learning and skill development. Each grade has a specific thematic focus, ensuring a comprehensive educational experience that prepares Boston's next generation of leaders for post-secondary success.



## RISE

**RISE** — Incoming 9th graders are introduced to the RISE (Realizing Interests through Support and Exploration) program during their last summer as a camper. They experience engaging workshops centered on self-discovery and exploration. At the end of their school year, they are able to apply for the three-year Leader in Training program.

## 10<sup>TH</sup> GRADE

**10th grade LIT** — The 10th grade curriculum is focused on exposing young leaders to a variety of career pathways. Monthly career panels allow youth to meet and engage with industry-leading professionals including professional athletes, artists, STEM and healthcare professionals, and entrepreneurs.

## 11<sup>TH</sup> GRADE

**11th grade LIT** — In the second year of the LIT program, youth explore the extensive variety of post-secondary educational options available to them and begin an actionable plan to achieve their post-secondary goals. Each young person will leave with a portfolio that outlines the pathways that they have chosen and how they intend to achieve the goals that they have set.

## 12<sup>TH</sup> GRADE

**12th grade LIT** — In preparation for graduation, the curriculum for 3rd year LITs is focused on guiding young leaders through the post-secondary application and financial aid processes. This includes college and trades programs, college essay writing, scholarship application, and financial literacy.

Over 100 former campers take on year-round roles as Leaders in Training, serving as near-peer mentors during the summer.

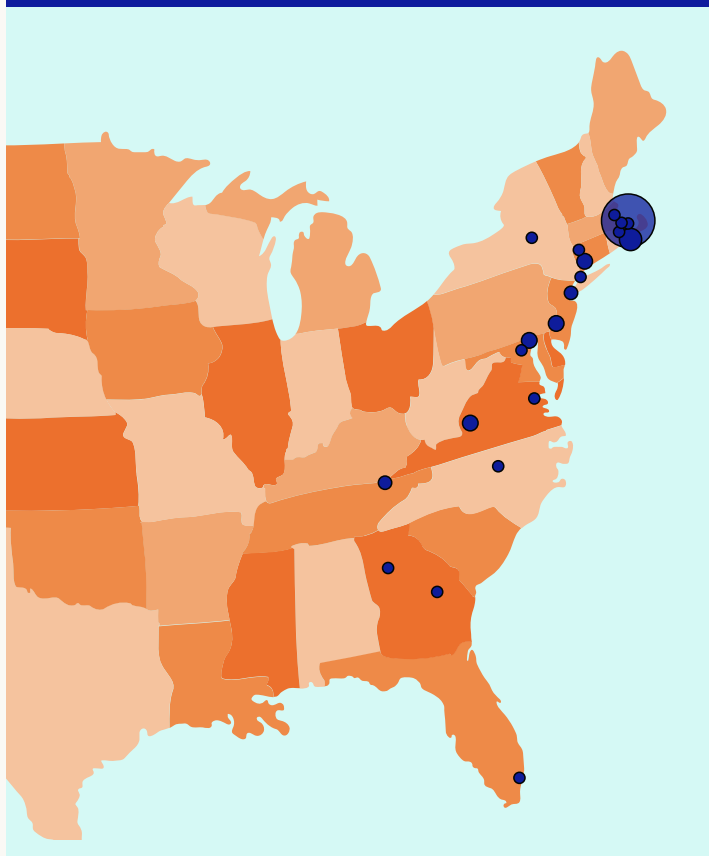
